



BLAKENEY PARISH COUNCIL

Outstanding Contribution to the Community Awards

- 1 The Outstanding Contribution to the Community Award is a tribute to a member of the community and confers no material honours or special privileges.
- 2 Those qualifying for the Outstanding Contribution award should be considered to have undertaken outstanding service to the community.
- 3 Any resident of Blakeney may be nominated for the award although nominees who do not have residential qualification will be considered at the Parish Council's discretion.
- 4 Nominations should be submitted using the application form to the Parish Clerk – the nominee having been proposed and seconded by two Blakeney residents or those with an interest in the village i.e. business/employment/community group leader or similar. Proposers cannot be a relative of the nominee.
- 5 Nominations should be submitted by 12pm on 30th April 2018.
- 6 The nominations will be presented to Councillors and the recipient(s) of the award(s) will be decided upon by the Full Council in June 2018.
- 7 Serving members of the Parish Council are not eligible for the award, but are eligible to propose or second nominations.
- 8 Presentation of the award will be made by The Chairman or other appointed person at an event to be announced.
- 9 The recipient(s) will receive a framed certificate and a small gift of appreciation.
- 10 The Council will actively promote this award each year in order to ensure a good number of nominations are received.
